

About

Us Mob & HIV is the Anwernekenhe National HIV Alliance (ANA) and AFAO's HIV health promotion resource for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities. The pocket-sized booklet aims to increase Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people's knowledge about HIV and its impacts. Us Mob & HIV has proven to be an always popular resource. This is the fourth edition of the resource.

Distribution

AFAO will distribute hardcopies of the booklet to all our state and territory member organisations. These member organisations will then distribute copies to local partners in their jurisdiction. Each organisation will be given an evaluation table to provide a monthly record of the following: organisations name, date, type of service, quantity distributed and location.

Please share the booklet with your partner organisations, such as people living with HIV (PLHIV) organisations, sex worker organisations, organisations for people who use drugs, state and territory Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations, Aboriginal Medical Services, clinics, General Practitioners, and other services This could include providing them with copies of the booklet, as well as asking them to promote the booklet's availability on their websites and social media channels.

Linking to the campaign poster



Distribution and Implementaion Suggestions



Working with service providers and clinicians

Working with service providers and clinicians to raise the awareness of HIV among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, is an important part of the implementation of this booklet.

Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations and Aboriginal Medical Services.

ACCHOs and AMSs are key partners for the distribution of the booklet. The strategies for distribution to these services and organisations will vary across different states and territories. In some jurisdictions, distribution of the booklet will be through the state/territory peak Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation, who will then distribute the booklets to their members, and Aboriginal Medical Services throughout their jurisdiction or you may also have connections with individual AMSs as well.

Other Distribution

Other service providers and clinicians, particularly those that have significant numbers of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients, would also be a useful distribution channel.

In addition to this booklet, there are four new factsheets (treatment as prevention, HIV testing, PrEP and PEP) coming soon.
