HEALTH PROMOTION

The WAAC Health Promotion team provide education to the community on a range of issues including HIV, STIs and BBVs.

This is done through a range of health promotion initiatives including workshops, presentations, outreach, expos, campaigns, and the provision of safer sex resources.

NEEDLE & SYRINGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

NSEP provides confidential, non-judgmental support to people who inject drugs across the Perth metro area, empowering clients with safer injecting knowledge, overdose prevention and distribution of naloxone.

We provide a wide range of sterile injecting equipment free on exchange (or at a low cost) and a space to safely dispose used injecting equipment. We also provide harm reduction education and referrals to support our clients.

ROCK SOLID

The Rock Solid methamphetamine peer education program focuses on reducing harms related to methamphetamine use.

The project recruits Peer Educators with large networks of people who may be using methamphetamine. They receive free harm reduction training and go on to educate their peers on ways to reduce harms related to their methamphetamine use.

VOLUNTEERING



COUNSELLING

We provide counselling support to people living with HIV and their partners and families, and young LGBTIQA+ people.

Appointments are either free or capacity-based fees negotiated with the counsellors upon assessment. Sessions are typically face-to-face and can be via telephone or Skype.

M CLINIC

M Clinic provides affordable, confidential, and non-judgmental HIV and STI testing, treatment, vaccinations and PrEP prescriptions for men who have sex with men, trans people and non-binary people in a relaxed environment.

FREEDOM CENTRE

Freedom Centre (FC) is here for young people ages 12-26 to support each other and their communities to be informed, happy and healthy about their sexuality, sex and gender.

Freedom Centre is led by our LGBTIQA+ Peer Education team for young LGBTIQA+ people.

WELLBEING WORKSHOPS

We run several Wellbeing Workshops throughout the year, focusing on peer support and mental health for LGBTIQA+ young people.

Workshops run over two days and are held both in WA metropolitan and regional locations.

FREEDOM STATE

Freedom State is WAAC's regional support project, delivering free support for LGBTIQA+ youth ages 12-25 in Bunbury, Geraldton, and Kalgoorlie.

We offer counselling and individualised support services for young LGBTIQA+ people. We also partner with the broader local community to develop its capacity and to create more inclusive, supportive, and connected regions.

WORKFORCE TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

WAAC offers a broad range of learning and development sessions that focus particularly on the areas of HIV, sexual health, sex positivity, anti-discrimination and inclusion.
