STI testing

Woken up with an *itch*, a *tickle* or a *rash* in spot you'd rather not mention? There's no shame in having an STI, we've all been there.

We offer appointment-based STI testing and treatment, so if you have a symptom or need to come in for a routine test, give us a call or book online and we'll be happy to have a look.

PrEP and PEP

To help reduce the spread of HIV and to make sex more enjoyable, we offer *PrEP* (pre-exposure prophylaxis) and *PEP* (post-exposure prophylaxis) prescriptions to our clients.

PrEP and PEP are medications used to reduce the risk of contracting HIV. For full details, please book an appointment with our doctors.

How often to test?

You should have an STI test every **3** months if you have sex with multiple partners, **1 year** if you are in a monogamous relationship, or **immediately** if you develop symptoms. We recommend having a checkup **every new partner**.

Outreach testing

Just like our clients, we like to get out and see what Perth has to offer, that's why occasionally you may bump into us doing STI testing around some venues in Perth.

HIV testing

We know testing can be scary, that's why we provide HIV testing in a casual and relaxed environment so no matter the outcome, we'll be here to support you through it.

Our nurses will take you in for a routine blood test like usual, and we'll be get back to you with results as soon as possible and go from there.

If you're not comfortable being tested by us at the clinic, we can offer you **ATOMO HIV self-testing kits** to use at home, which can give you results after 15 minutes.

Vaccinations

As part of our service, we offer vaccinations for a range of viruses to our patients who are not already immune, including for:

- Hepatitis A and B
- HPV, and
- MPX (monkeypox)

It is necessary to have an appointment for all vaccinations.

Gender affirming care

Available for our trans, gender diverse, and non-binary clients who are looking to start their transition, we are proud to offer gender affirming care for our community.

Booking in for our gender affirming care requires a referral from a GP to see our Sexual Health Physician, *Dr. Joseph Cotter (he/him)*.
