

MEDICINES & DRIVING

Just because a medication is prescribed by a doctor does **NOT** mean it's OK to drive. Some prescription drugs can impair your ability to drive safely.

WA has a **zero tolerance** approach to THC (Tetrahydrocannabinol) found in cannabis. Any amount found in a roadside saliva test will result in a **conviction for drug driving**.

A police officer can conduct a driver assessment as part of their observations of the driver's behaviour, demeanour and condition which can include:

- (a) there is any apparent injury to the driver;
- (b) there are any unusual or indicative skin responses;
- (c) there is a smell of alcohol;
- (d) the driver's –
 - (i) speech; or
 - (ii) action; or
 - (iii) movement; or
 - (iv) balance, appears affected;
- (e) the appearance of the driver's eyes indicates drug ingestion (dilated, constricted, bloodshot, etc.);
- (f) the driver's rate or manner of breathing appears affected by drugs;
- (g) the driver's attitude or the appearance of the driver's clothing appears to indicate drug ingestion;
- (h) the driver's general comprehension appears affected by drugs.
